## Installation

### Lightroom 2+

1. Launch Lightroom.
2. From **Metadata/Import Keywords...** select the file **UltraTAGFree\*-.txt**.  
Click on **Choose** and wait a few moments.
3. When installed you should see the catalog in the appropriate panel.

### Bridge 2.1+ (CS3+)

1. Launch Bridge.
2. In the upper right hand corner of the Keyword palette, click on the tiny downward pointing arrow and select **Import...**. Navigate to the file **UltraTAGFree\*-.txt**. Click on **Choose** and wait a few moments.
3. When installed correctly you should see the catalog in the Keyword palette.

### Capture One Pro 9.3+

1. Launch Sie Capture One.
2. Click on Panel **Metadata (i)**.
3. Click on **Catalog Keywords (...) / Import Keywords into Library / Keyword Text File**
4. Navigate to the file **UltraTAGFree\*-.txt** and click on **Open**.
5. When installed correctly you should see the catalog in the Metadata-Panel.

## Fotostation Pro 6+

1. Rename UltraTAGFree\*-.txt to 15\_20.txt.
2. Copy the file 15\_20.txt to the following folder:

for Windows XP

"C:\Documents and Settings\<User>\Application Data\FotoWare\FotoStation\Configuration\Localized\English\Metadata\Quick Lists\"

for Windows Vista, 7, 8 and 10

"C:\Users\<User>\AppData\Roaming\FotoWare\FotoStation\Configuration\Localized\English\Metadata\Quick Lists\"

for Mac OSX

"<YourHD>/Library/Application/Support/FotoWare/FotoStation/Configuration/Localized/English/Metadata/Quick Lists\"

3. Launch Fotostation Pro.
4. If installed correctly on the default annotation dialog (Mac: Command + T or Windows: Control + T) you should see two icons to right of the keyword field. Clicking on the downward pointing arrow will reveal the keyword catalog.

## Photo Mechanic v4.5+

1. Launch Photo Mechanic.
2. From Image/Structured Keywords/Load select the file UltraTAGFree\*-.txt and click on Load or Merge. The Merge button will retain any changes you have made to catalog already included with Photo Mechanic. The Load button will replace the existing catalog with the new catalog.
3. When installed on the panel Structured Keywords you should see the catalog.

## IDimager 4+

1. Launch IDimager.
2. From Tools/Catalog Import/Import Vocabularies/Import from UltraTAG choose the file UltraTAGFree\*-.txt and wait.
3. When installed on the panel Catalog Explorer/Catalog Labels you should see the catalog.

## Breeze Browser Pro 1.9+

1. Rename UltraTAGFree\*-.txt to keywords.txt.
2. Copy the file "keywords.txt" to the folder "C:\Program Files\BreezeSys\BreezeBrowserPro\".
3. Launch Breeze Browser.
4. You can view the keyword catalog under the Edit menu.

## Caption Writer II 4.5+

1. Launch Caption Writer.
2. From Window / Thesaurus / Import/Export / Import choose the file UltraTAGFree\*-.txt.
3. When installed on the panel Thesaurus you should see the catalog.
